To qualify for Deferred Disposition, you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be at least age 17 at time of offense.
- Must not have had a Commercial Driver’s License at the time of the offense or have one presently.
- Violation was not in a construction zone with worker’s present
- The citation was not a result of an accident
- You must not have illegally passed a school bus loading or unloading.

I, the undersigned defendant, do hereby waive the filing and reading of a sworn complaint, waive my right to trial (jury or non-jury), and enter my plea of no contest to the above numbered case and request that I be granted deferred disposition. I understand by entering a plea of no contest, I agree to pay the court-ordered fines, court costs, and/or fees. I do also swear, or affirm, that I meet all of the qualifications listed above to request the Deferred Disposition option.

I understand that if I was under 25 years of age on the date of the offense, I must complete a Driving Safety Course. I also understand that if I have a Provisional Driver’s license, I must re-take the DPS Driving Exam.

This request must be submitted to the court on or before the appear by date on your citation. Call the court @940-686-4707 for instructions and amount **only**. Do **not** pay online unless/until instructed by the clerk that you may do so. Upon approval by the Judge, the **deferral period of 180 days will begin** and you will have 90 DAYS from the start of the of the deferred period to pay the balance in full and complete any required sanctions.

The defendant **MUST NOT BE CONVICTED** of any similar violations of the law during the deferred period. **Additionally, if a Driving Safety Course is required, I must return my completion certificate to the Court prior to the end of the Deferral period. Also, if a DPS Driving Exam is required, I must submit proof of the examination to the Court prior to the end of the Deferral period.**

By signing below, I acknowledge the terms/requirements of the Deferred Disposition and swear or affirm that I meet the qualifications listed above.
