

# Trash and Recycling 2021



The City of Pilot Point contracts with Waste Connections for recycling and trash pickup.

- Receptacles should be placed by the street by 7:00AM on the day of pick up.
- Lids MUST be closed.
- If you have more than one receptacle they must be placed 3 feet apart.

Trash is picked up weekly.

**North Side every Monday:** Addresses on Main St. and north of Main St.

**South Side every Tuesday:**

Addresses south of Main St.

**Bulk Trash Temporary Change**

Picked up twice a month on the Friday BEFORE the originally scheduled pick up date

Recycling is picked up every other week.

**North Side every other Wednesday:**

Addresses on Main St. and north of Main St.

**South Side every other Thursday:**

Addresses south of Main St.

## RESIDENTIAL TRASH GUIDELINES

All of your household trash and yard waste can be placed in your GREEN trash toter. All of the trash must fit inside your toter with the lid COMPLETELY closed. Since the driver doesn't leave the vehicle, no trash will be collected if it is on top of or beside the toter. The most important thing to remember: **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR TOTER ON THE CURB BY 7:00AM.** The toter should be placed at the edge of the driveway at the road with the handle facing the residence. Parked vehicles and other obstacles (i.e., gas meters, fences, electrical boxes, cable boxes, etc.) should be at least 3 feet from the cart.

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED:

- ⊗ Antifreeze
- ⊗ Batteries
- ⊗ Garden Chemicals
- ⊗ Gasoline
- ⊗ Hazardous Paint
- ⊗ Pool Chemicals
- ⊗ Wet Paint
- ⊗ Tires

## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Recyclable materials do not need to be sorted. All of the recycling must fit inside your BLUE toter with the lid COMPLETELY closed. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR TOTER ON THE CURB BY 7:00AM.** The toter should be placed at the edge of the driveway at the road with the handle facing the residence. Parked vehicles and other obstacles should be at least 3 feet from the cart.

### DO SAVE THESE RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

- ✓ Aluminum/Steel: Food & Beverage ONLY
- ✓ Cardboard: Brown/White Cardboard any kind
- ✓ Glass: Food & Beverage ONLY
- ✓ Paper: Mail-Magazines-Newspaper-Shredded
- ✓ **Plastics #1 through #5 & #7**

### DON'T SAVE THESE NON-RECYCLABLE ITEMS:

- ⊗ Packing Peanuts
- ⊗ Paper Towels
- ⊗ Pizza Boxes
- ⊗ Polystyrene Foam
- ⊗ Styrofoam
- ⊗ Tissue paper
- ⊗ Auto glass
- ⊗ Ceramics
- ⊗ China
- ⊗ Light bulbs
- ⊗ Television tubes
- ⊗ Window glass
- ⊗ Aerosol cans
- ⊗ Aluminum foil
- ⊗ Paint cans
- ⊗ Foil lined cardboard food and drink containers

### KEEP IT RECYCLABLE

If a Blue Recycling Toter is found to have more than 10% contaminated materials inside; the pick up will be rejected and the blue toter will be tagged by Waste Connections. The resident will receive a \$15.00 penalty.

## BULK WASTE GUIDELINES

Bulk waste will be collected on the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month. **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR ITEMS ON THE CURB BY 7:00AM.** Each household is allowed 4 cubic yards (imagine about 4 of the green trash toters) of bulk waste per pick up. It is not necessary to schedule the pickup. Simply put it out on the curb.

### BULK ITEMS CAN INCLUDE:

- ✓ Furniture
- ✓ Appliances (Refrigerators, Freezers, and Air Conditioners **MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE** verifying that all Freon has been removed responsibly)
- ✓ Extra bagged trash
- ✓ Yard Waste
- ✓ Limbs (**MUST** be bundled and tied in 4 ft. sections and weighing less than 40 lbs.)
- ✓ Lumber (All nails **MUST** be removed. Bundled and tied in 4 ft. sections and weighing less than 40 lbs.)
- ✓ Christmas Trees (**MUST** be bundled and tied in 4 ft. sections and weighing less than 40 lbs.)

NO HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE WILL BE COLLECTED. Unfortunately, The City of Pilot Point and Waste Connections do not have a way to dispose of Hazardous Household Waste.

Please call and report *only if you followed all guidelines* and your trash, bulk or recycling was not picked up.
